### 3. **St. Regis Atlanta**



Location: Atlanta, Georgia  
Located in the heart of Buckhead at The St. Regis Atlanta, this stunning gem offers an incredibly unique and treasured visual experience for diners when they visit the in-house restaurant. Green lacquered walls provide the backdrop for the art, which can be

viewed from every vantage point. A collection of important paintings, including works from masters Picasso, Freud, Bacon, Soutine, van Gogh, and Chagall have been installed on the walls of **Atlas**—a new restaurant by famed Atlanta chef and restaurateur Gerry Klaskala and the Tavistock Group. This impressive grouping features two-dozen 20th century masterworks from the Lewis Collection, one of the most significant private art collections in the world. Noteworthy paintings displayed at Atlas include Pablo Picasso's "Dora Maar," Francis Bacon's "Study for Portrait," Pablo Picasso's "La Famille," Vincent van Gogh's "Vieux se chauffant," and Marc Chagall's "Le Femme Rouge."
